

Alumni Scholarship Nomination Form

Graduates of the Columbus School of Law may nominate first-year or transfers students for this \$1,000 award, renewable for up to four years. Receipt of the grant is not automatic. Limited funding is available and will be awarded based on a strong personal profile, shown through leadership experience and extracurricular activities.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must be a U.S. citizen applying for full-time study at the Columbus School of Law in Washington, D.C.
- May not be a currently enrolled student at Columbus School of Law.

Note: If this scholarship is not requested prior to enrolling as a new first-year or transfer student, subsequent application is not permitted.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- All paperwork for scholarships and grants must be submitted with the Application for Admission and must be received along with all other materials submitted in support of a complete application.
- Once an admissions decision and a scholarship recommendation have been made, adjustments are not possible.
