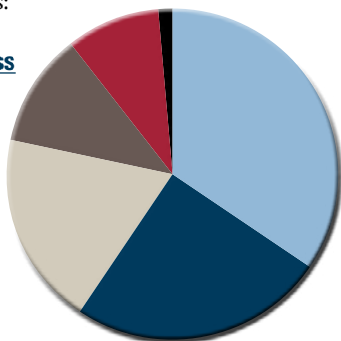


Employment Outcomes: Class of 2014
