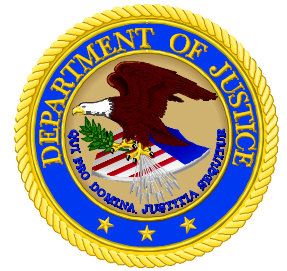

#### [ELIGIBILITY FOR THE HONORS PROGRAM](#)

ELIGIBILITY IS GENERALLY LIMITED TO GRADUATING LAW STUDENTS AND RECENT LAW SCHOOL GRADUATES WHO ENTERED JUDICIAL CLERKSHIPS, GRADUATE LAW PROGRAMS, OR QUALIFYING FELLOWSHIPS WITHIN 9 MONTHS OF LAW SCHOOL GRADUATION AND WHO MEET ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS. #### [ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SUMMER LAW INTERN PROGRAM](#)

LAW STUDENTS WHO HAVE COMPLETED AT LEAST ONE FULL SEMESTER OF LEGAL STUDY BY THE APPLICATION DEADLINE ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. MOST SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS INTERN THE SUMMER BETWEEN THEIR SECOND AND THIRD YEAR OF LAW SCHOOL; HOWEVER, GRADUATING LAW STUDENTS WHO ARE ENTERING A JUDICIAL CLERKSHIP OR FULL-TIME GRADUATE LAW PROGRAM MAY INTERN FOLLOWING GRADUATION SUBJECT TO ELIGIBILITY RULES.
