


Signing Up For Pro Bono Projects On TWEN

2. In the search box enter “Pro Bono at CUA Law” and select “+Add.”





You can participate in a pro bono project you have sourced yourself, however, you must seek the prior approval of the Pro Bono Coordinator for the project to be considered for pro bono.

Please Note: If you are considering sitting the New York State bar, click [here](#) to learn about the mandatory 50-hour pro bono requirement. The definition of what qualifies as pro bono under the New York rule is expansive, however, projects for which students receive pro bono credit at CUA Law may not fall within it. You are strongly encouraged to complete an [Affidavit of Compliance](#) as you complete each project, rather than waiting until you apply for admission to the bar. The Affidavit requires notarization and supervisor certification. Inquiries may be made directly to the Court via ProBonoRule@nycourts.gov.
