

Natasha Vij Greiner is the National Associate Director for the Investment Adviser/Investment Company Examination Program and Associate Director for the Washington, DC Investment Adviser/Investment Company Examination Program within the SEC's Division of Examinations. Prior to these roles, she was the Acting Chief Counsel and an Assistant Chief Counsel in the SEC's Division of Trading and Markets' Office of Chief Counsel where she provided legal and policy advice on matters affecting various market participants, including broker-dealers and self-regulatory organizations, and the overall operation of the securities markets. Prior to joining the Division of Trading and Markets in 2012, Ms. Greiner worked in the SEC's Division of Enforcement for eight years.
