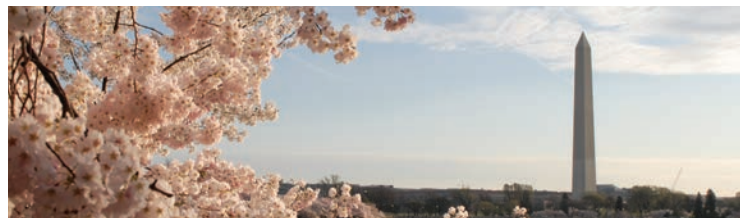

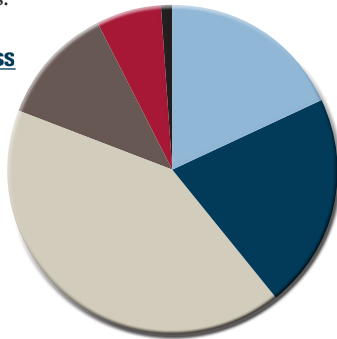


Employment Outcomes: Class of 2017
