
As we continue to test and filter online options, Panopto seems to be rising to the best practices level, especially when considering larger groups. Meet seems easier to use for small groups, but webcasting or streaming a Panopto session with a chat session may be best. Please explore the various settings on the Overview and Share pages that include scheduling, quality, editing, and adding participants. My demo session is named Panopto v Meet.

Here is how to do it and we are happy to go over it with you in person as well.

This is how to set up a streaming session in advance. After opening Panopto and clicking on the Create button you will see the Webcast option.

In the Actions section click on the share tab. Anyone with the link streamlines the operation, but Anyone at your organization with link should work.



You would click the button in the upper left and mouse to the right to get to Settings which brings you back to the Overview page.




On the Overview page click Record to start your session.
