Due Dates, Cancellation and Refund Policies International Business and Trade Law Program in Cracow, Poland June 15 to July 17, 2019

Application due date: Monday, April 1, 2019 or until Program reaches capacity. (Non-refundable application fee of \$100 must be received to complete the application.)

Deposit due date: Monday, April 1, 2019 (Deposit of \$500 will be applied to Program Fee).

Withdrawals:

Students may withdraw from the Program without financial penalty, with the exception of the non-refundable application fee of \$100, by **April 15, 2019.**

To withdraw, written notification must be submitted in hard copy or by email to the administrator of the Summer Abroad Law Programs - Ms. Constantia Dedoulis, Law Bldg. Rm. 475A and <u>dedoulis@law.edu</u>. Verbal cancellations will <u>not</u> be accepted.

(Note that <u>in all circumstances</u>, airfare and student arranged housing is the sole responsibility of participants, and students must work with ticket issuer and/or housing provider to negotiate any possible refund.)

Cancellation: If Catholic University must cancel the Program due to unforeseen circumstances, students will receive a full refund of all tuition and fees paid, including the application fee. Students will receive prompt notification of such a cancellation via e-mail and a written letter. If such a cancellation occurs after a deposit has been made, the Program director and staff will use their best efforts to make arrangements for each student enrolled to attend a similar program, if the student so desires.

Refund Policy:

On or before April 15, 2019: 100% of tuition and deposit paid will be refunded to student. Application fee will not be refunded.

Between April 16 and June 1, 2019: 100% of tuition will be refunded to the student. Application fee and deposit will not be refunded.

CUA-arranged housing at Bratniak Dormitory, Cracow:

By March 31, 2019, students must submit a signed room reservation form to request CUA-arranged accommodations at the Bratniak Dormitory. CUA Enrollment Services will bill students for housing. The housing fee will appear in the Summer 2018 term billing statement. In the event a student must cancel his or her reservation, the following refund schedule will be observed.

On or before May 15, 2018: Students who have signed room reservations may receive a 100% refund.

Between May 16 to 31, 2018: Students will be responsible for 50% of the housing bill.

As of June 1, 2018: Students will be responsible for housing in full (100%), and they will not be entitled to a refund.

Cracow Tuition:

Due to the short-term of the international summer program, students are strongly discouraged from modifying their course schedule. However, with the approval of Professor Ludwikowski, students may add/drop classes within 48 hours of the first day of the course. Specific dates and times will be provided with the summer abroad schedule.
