Please Note: Capstone courses meet the Transition to Practice requirement only if taken in a student's 3rd or 4th year.

Please Note: If a student completes one of the upper-level writing requirements within a 6 credit TtP course, he or she will fulfill all at once the Experiential Learning Requirement and one half of the upper-level writing requirement. For 3L or 4L students operating under the Professional Skills rule, this 6 credit course would meet the TtP requirement, one half of the upper-level writing requirement and the Professional Skills requirement.

Please Note: If a student completes one of the upper-level writing requirements within a 3 or 4 credit TtP course, he or she will fulfill one-half of the upper-level writing requirement and a portion (3 or 4 credits) of the Experiential Learning Requirement, including the TtP requirement. For 3L or 4L students operating under the old rule, the student would meet either the TtP requirement and one half of the upper-level writing

requirement or the TtP requirement and the Professional Skills requirement.

** To use this course to fulfill the transition-to-practice requirement, a student must also successfully complete the Immigration Law: Employment, Family and Naturalization course. Both courses must be taken in a student's third or fourth year to satisfy the TtP requirement.
