Please Note: If a student completes one of the upper-level writing requirements within a 6 credit TtP course, he or she will fulfill all at once the Experiential Learning Requirement and one half of the upper-level writing requirement.

Please Note: If a student completes one of the upper-level writing requirements within a 3 or 4 credit TtP course, he or she will fulfill one-half of the upper-level writing requirement and a portion (3 or 4 credits) of the Experiential Learning Requirement, including the TtP requirement.

** To use this course to fulfill the transition-to-practice requirement, a student must also successfully complete the Immigration Law: Deportation and Asylum course. Both courses must be taken in a student's third or fourth year to satisfy the TtP requirement.
